The first time you click the link you will be prompted to install the Zoom Meetings application. The next time you click the link it should launch the Zoom Meetings application on your computer.

What If I Don't Have A Camera

If your computer doesn't have a camera then you will be able to see others but they will not be able to see you.

What If I Don't Have A Microphone

If your computer doesn't have a microphone, please select the 'Phone Call' audio conference option when prompted and click the 'Done' button.

To join by phone, please dial the telephone number below. You will then be asked to enter the 9 digit meeting ID on your telephone keypad followed by the # key. When asked for a participant ID, just press the # key.

During the call you can mute and unmute your phone by pressing *6 on your telephone keypad.



If you have not yet installed the Zoom Meetings application, please click on the 'download & run Zoom' link and follow the instructions to install the application.


If you have the Zoom Meetings application installed, please click on the 'Open Zoom Meetings' button. If this button is not showing, please click on the 'click here' link.

If you launch the Zoom Meetings application directly you will see a screen like the one below.



Click the 'Join a Meeting' button, enter your name and the meeting ID 112 135 361, and click the 'Join' button.

When the Zoom Meetings application has launched you should see a screen like the one below.



If your computer has speakers and a microphone please click 'Join with Computer Audio', otherwise select the 'Phone Call' tab and you should see a screen like the one below.



Please dial 0131 460 1196 on your landline or mobile phone. When prompted for the meeting ID, press 112 135 361 followed by the # key. When asked for a participant ID, just press the # key. Finally please press the 'Done' button.

When you have been admitted you should see a screen like the one below.



Please note the buttons along the bottom of the screen:

- Turns your microphone on and off. Please turn off if you are not speaking.
- Turns your camera on and off.
- Allows you to see a list of all participants.
- Allows you to see messages, and send and reply to messages. By default messages are visible to all participants.

NOTE: the buttons will appear and disappear if you press the 'alt' key.
